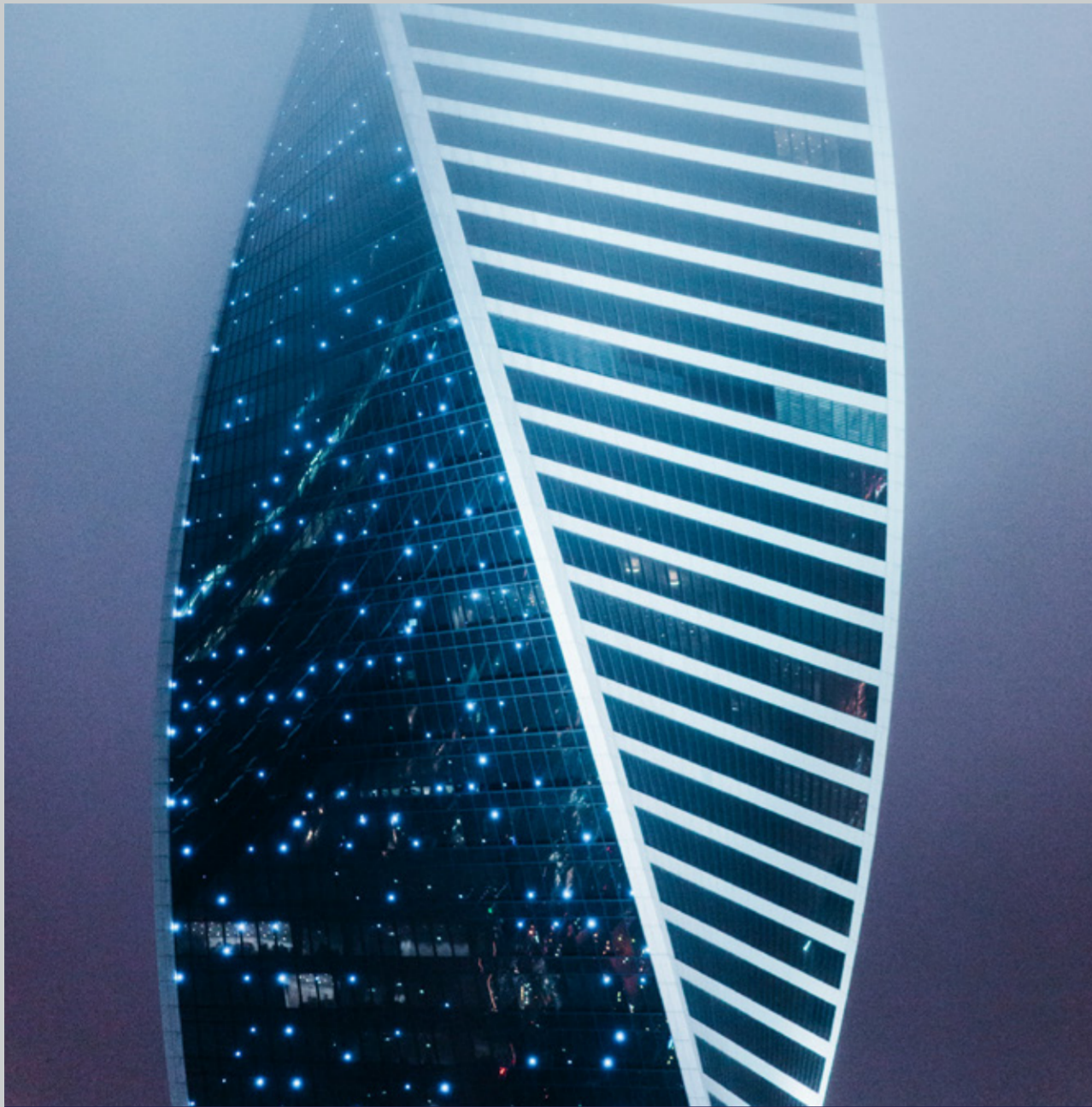

## Immortal intelligence and rise of the DNA-independent humanity
